TESTING THIS WEEK: The third cycle of iReady testing continues this week. iReady is the K-8 district wide assessment tool used to guide instruction in reading and math. It is important that we get accurate data during iReady testing. While realizing that our virtual students may utilize parents or other family members for assistance with activities assigned by teachers, please do not get assistance during iReady testing. The test is designed to challenge students and they may see test questions on materials they've never studied before and that's OK. iReady is not a pass or fail test, it is a tool that helps teachers make instructional decisions.
