

- Once accepted students must maintain a minimum 2.75 Grade Point Average (GPA) for grade 6th, 3.0 for grades 7/8th and maintain a C or better in the core academic classes.
- Students must adhere to the Southfield Public Schools' Student Code of Conduct. Student's inability to adhere to the SPS Student Code of Conduct and/or maintain a minimum 2.75 Grade Point Average (GPA) for grade 6th and 3.0 grades 7/8th will result in permanent dismissal from UMSA.
- Students must adhere to the dress code policy.
- Education is a shared responsibility of the student, school, and parents. I
