Section 98 C- Learning Loss Grant





What is 98c Learning Loss Grant

Section 98c appropriates \$52,056,000 in federal funding to address learning loss as part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund and part of the federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) II Fund



Eligibility

- Apply to MDE no later than November 30, 2022.
- By October 30, 2022, at a public meeting of the board a presentation provided on how funding received under section 98c will be used to address learning loss
- A link to the plan to address learning loss that is posted on the district's website
- Post updates to the plan on the district's website.
- A brief description of the district metrics to be used to determine the impact of the district's funded initiatives.

Plan

- **Renew & Utilize** our i-Ready Subscription for all K-8 Students to continue progress monitoring and evaluating our student's growth during school and afterschool programs.
- **Make mid-course corrections** based on data by assessing each student in the and develop short-term academic goals for afterschool programs as well as our summer school programs.
- **Ongoing progress monitoring** for each student. Create a strong foundation for our K-8 learners by utilizing i-Ready in our afterschool Program as well as for our summer school program that is skill-based in reading and mathematics in grades K-8.



Plan

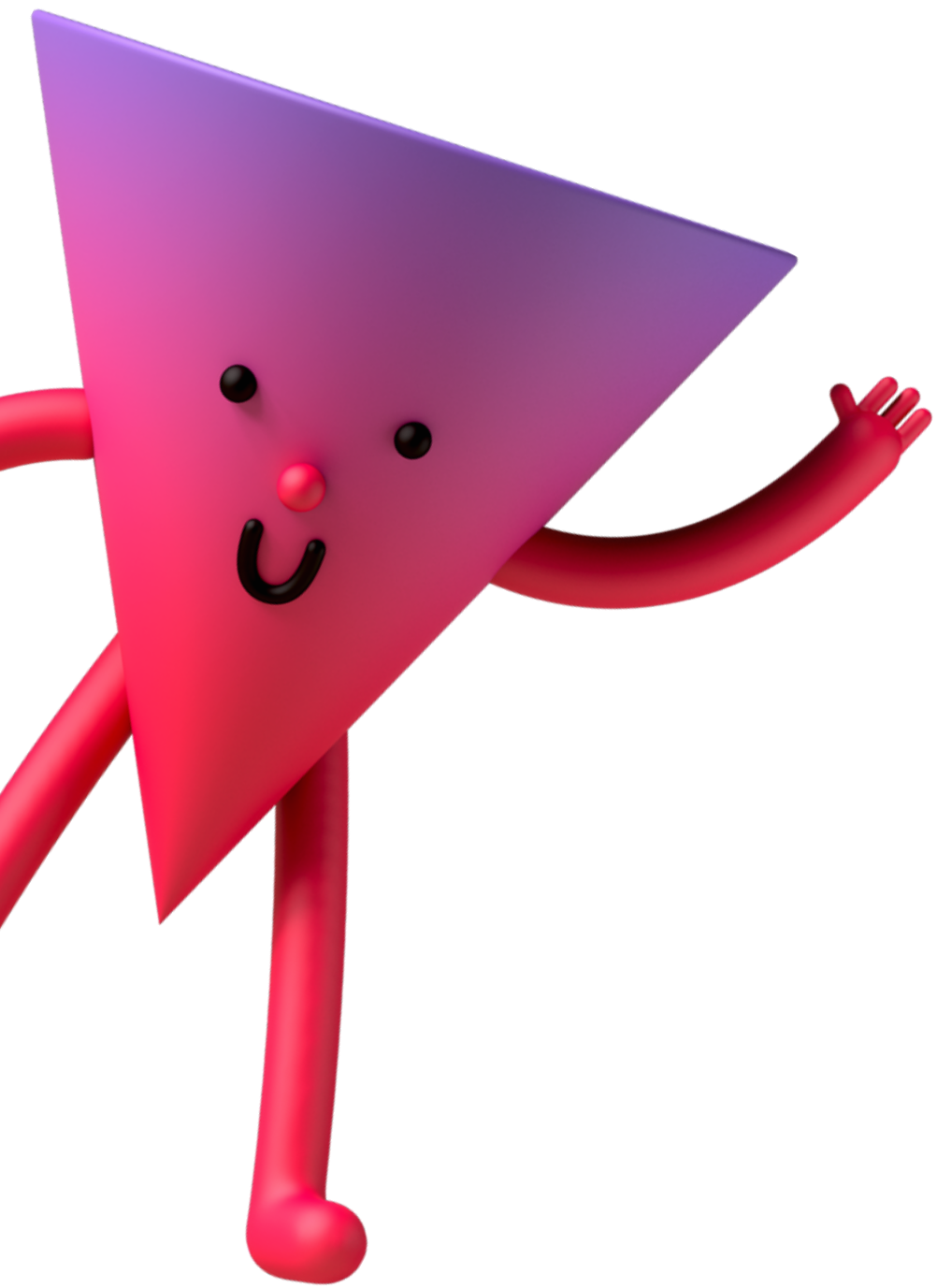
- **Set goals based on student needs.** Consider student's needs, such as grade-level benchmarks they must meet, to identify specific objectives. Structure activities to build skills and allow students to show their mastery.
- **Integrate writing with reading and math:** Teaching the fundamentals of writing can mean helping students understand the basics of storytelling and solving word problems by utilizing the writing teacher toolbox in i-Ready. Use resources that appeal to various students' interests.
- **Assess students' progress over time.** Check on their development and provide thoughtful, constructive feedback based on students' individual learning plans.
